## **CIRCULAR TO DEPARTMENTS AND AUTHORITIES NO. 2 OF 2004**

### **QUEEN'S BIRTHDAY PUBLIC HOLIDAY 2006 - 2008**

Section 5 of the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1972 (WA)*, provides for the Celebration Day for the Anniversary of the Birthday of the Reigning Sovereign ("Queen's Birthday public holiday"), to be appointed annually by proclamation.

The following dates have been proclaimed as the Queen's Birthday public holiday for 2006 – 2008:

Monday 2 October 2006

Monday 1 October 2007

Monday 29 September 2008

**NOTE:** Some non-metropolitan local government authorities may choose to celebrate the Queen's Birthday public holiday on a day of local significance in lieu of the official date. This information will be provided in a future circular.
