CIRCULAR TO DEPARTMENTS AND AUTHORITIES NO. 4 OF 2004

**WITHDRAWAL OF CIRCULAR 11 OF 1973: GOVERNMENT WAGES EMPLOYEES NORTH OF 26<sup>TH</sup> PARALLEL RECREATIONAL LEAVE – FARE CONCESSIONS**

I refer to Industrial Employees' Circular No.11 of 1973, which provides a recreational leave fare concession for Government wages employees employed north of the 26<sup>th</sup> parallel.

Please be advised that Circular 11 of 1973 has been withdrawn, effective from the date of this circular. As a consequence, Circular 16 of 1973 and Circular 1 of 1974 have also been withdrawn, effective from the same date.

Agencies should apply fare concessions (annual leave travel concession) in accordance with relevant awards and/or industrial agreements.
