CIRCULAR TO DEPARTMENTS AND AUTHORITIES NO. 5 OF 2010

QUEEN'S BIRTHDAY PUBLIC HOLIDAY 2010 – ALTERNATIVE DATES FOR SHIRE OF EAST PILBARA, SHIRE OF ROEBOURNE AND TOWN OF PORT HEDLAND

This year, the Queen's Birthday public holiday in Western Australia is fixed as Monday 27 September.

Section 8(1) of the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1972* enables the Governor to proclaim alternative public holiday dates either throughout the State or within a particular district.

The Governor has proclaimed the following alternative dates to observe the Queen's Birthday public holiday this year within the district and locality specified:

Local Government Authority	Alternative Date	Area Affected
Town of Port Hedland	Monday, 2 August 2010 Port Hedland Cup Day	The area comprising the Town of Port Hedland.
Shire of Roebourne	Monday, 2 August 2010 Community Festival (FeNaCING)	The area comprising the Shire of Roebourne.
Shire of East Pilbara	Monday, 5 July 2010 Annual Marble Bar Cup Race Day	The area comprising the town of Marble Bar and the area of the Shire comprising a 150km radius from the town including the town of Nullagine.
Shire of East Pilbara	Monday, 16 August 2010 Annual Fortescue Festival	The area comprising the town of Newman and that portion of the Shire from the southern boundary to a point 150km radius northwards, east and west.

These alternative dates are in lieu of Monday 27 September. Within the district and locality specified, 27 September will be regarded as an ordinary working day and the alternative date will be regarded as the Queen's Birthday public holiday for 2010.
