



## Circular 06/2021 – Alternative public holiday dates for specified regions for the Celebration Day for the Anniversary of the Birthday of the Reigning Sovereign

The Celebration Day for the Anniversary of the Birthday of the Reigning Sovereign public holiday – previously known as the Queen’s Birthday public holiday – will generally be observed on Monday 27 September 2021 in Western Australia.

Section 8(1) of the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1972* allows the Governor to declare alternative dates for public holidays in specified regions.

By proclamation published in *Government Gazette No. 83 of 2021*, the Governor has declared the following alternative dates in specified regions for the Celebration Day for the Anniversary of the Birthday of the Reigning Sovereign public holiday in 2021:

Specified region	Alternative date	Area affected
Town of Port Hedland	Monday 2 August 2021	The Port Hedland local government district
City of Karratha	Monday 2 August 2021	The Karratha local government district

For employment purposes, Monday 27 September 2021 will be regarded as an ordinary working day within each region specified above.
